

- Long history of supporting Australian multiculturalism, having established the Multicultural Student Club at La Trobe University in 1978, the first of its kind in Australia
- Named on the HereSheIs list of inspiring Australian women with special skills for motivating women of ethnic backgrounds to flourish and integrate in Australia and other achievements, including being the 1st Australian female national manager in international meat exports and 1st female owner-operator of a travel agency
- Led and won the first ever Australian Tax Office (ATO) case relating to GST against the national Taxi industry
- Supported hundreds of Australian small businesses through events and seminars over a 25 year career with the ATO
- Awarded the ATO Harmony Hero award for outstanding community engagement, the only accolade of its kind ever awarded by the ATO
- Board Member of the Victorian Immigrant & Refugee Women Coalition
- Featured on SBS for her role with the Australian Electoral Commission, in which she educated community organisations on voting
- Selected to present and recite poetry at the Opening Ceremony of the Arabic Community contribution at the Parliament exhibition
- Committee member of the Melbourne Poet Union and Suraya Cultural forum
- Serve as committee member for various multifaith and diversity-focused groups and NGOs
- First female writer to have poetry included in the curriculum of Bagdad University
- Human rights advocate with presentations and lectures given across the world, from Washington DC to Beirut and other international universities
